Intensive Summer Camp: English course, Swimming and Fun activities

As all activities are conducted in English during our Summer Camp children are totally immersed in the English language. Children are permanently stimulated by English speaking teachers and have the possibility of meeting children of other nationalities.

The children really enjoy the day participating in very varied activities, swimming, art and craft, games and songs, etc. according to the age group.



The high level of English of our pupils provides fluency, spontaneity, and an accent which can only be acquired at a very early age.

Learning or improving English through play and exercise and meeting other children in a real British environment, is exciting, stimulating and enriching.

Age Range

Children between 1 and 7 years of age.

Activities

Swimming Activity.

During the swimming activity the children are supervised by the Lifeguard, the swimming teacher and the class teacher.

For their own security children must wear armbands, until the swimming teacher decides that the child is able to swim safely without them.

Children will need:

- A labelled bag with a full change of clothes, swimming costume, armbands, and a towel.
- The shoes should be easy to fasten, and must be labelled as well
- The bag with all the swimming things will stay in school until Friday when it will be sent home for washing.

Swimming activities will be substituted with other activities for children under 2 years old.



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Oral Space

Oral Space: Spoken English work. throughout the day, the children will participate in spoken English activities such as:

- Nursery Rhymes
- Flash cards (Visual vocabulary)
- Storytelling
- Puppet shows

Through these activities the children will learn new vocabulary and will improve their comprehension skills in a fun way.

Art and Craft

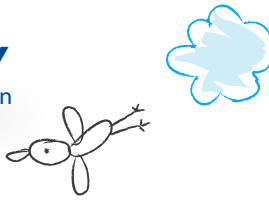
In the Summer Camp, art and craft activities are a fundamental part of our day to day. The kids will participate in a great variety of workshops working with different techniques and materials.
